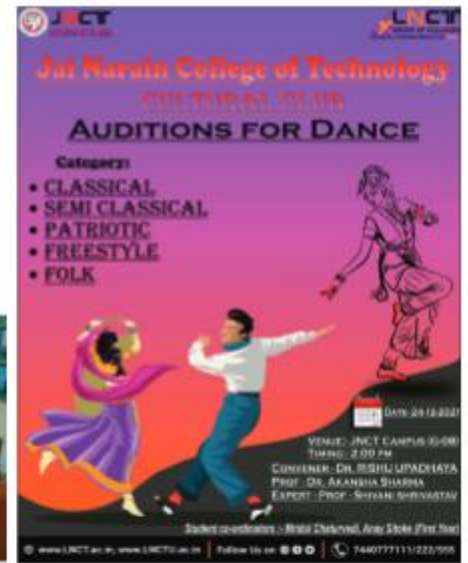
In the past few years N.C.C. has become very popular among the youngsters. For this reason, the Government has made the N.C.C. compulsory in colleges.

culture in the students which to increase the strength of various activities conducted by Institution so that students can learn the value of taken part in various community service programmes.

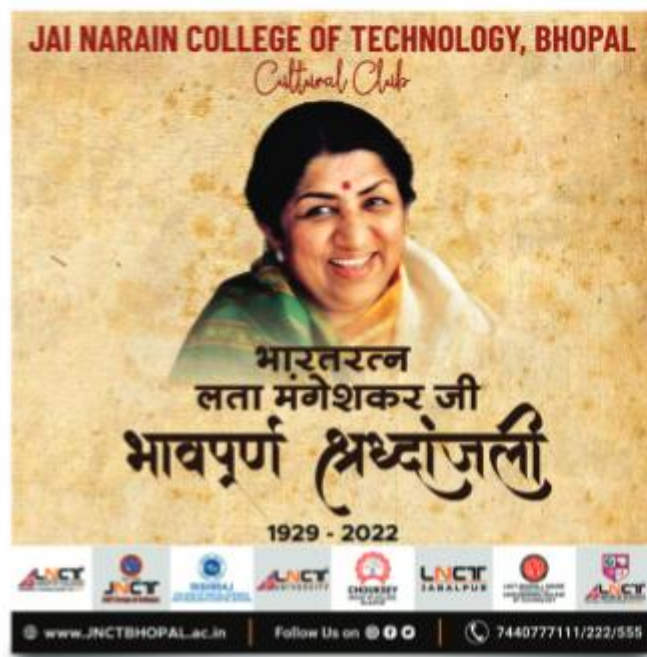

The Nature Trail Walk was organized at Van Vihar National Park.

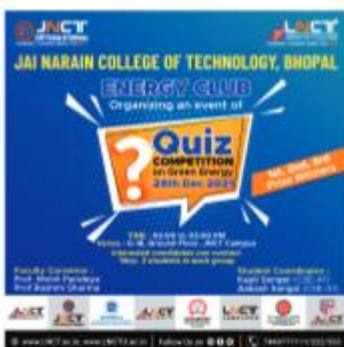


Nature Photography Contest

Literary Club

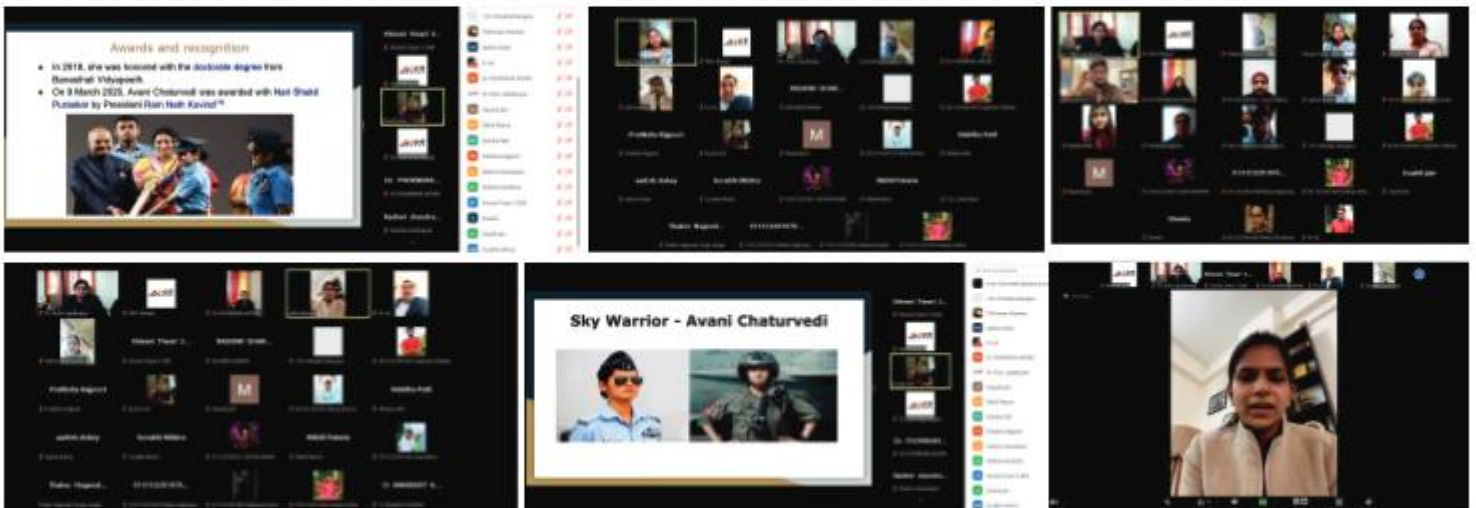
We do believe that : - **“A pen is mightier than a sword.”**
